York Region District School Board requires groups of 15 students to be accompanied by their own adult chaperone. The chaperone will assume custodial duties and be the official contact regarding the international students during their attendance and stay at the designated program.

When accepting groups, we expect:

- one chaperone to accompany every fifteen students.
- each chaperone's level of English to be at least at the intermediate level.
- each chaperone to remain at the program location throughout the program.
- each chaperone to have a cell phone and to be available to liaise with the students and International Education staff at all times.
- each chaperone to accompany students on excursions and during programmed activities.
- each chaperone to communicate with students' parents, program coordinator and YRDSB when issues arise and for updates.
- each chaperone to speak on behalf of the students' parents regarding any issues raised.
- each chaperone to monitor the students' attendance at classes and activities and to monitor students' academic progress.
- each chaperone to address any minor issues the students may have while in the program with the appropriate staff.
